BACKGROUND

The intent of the land code initiative is to develop a land management code that will replace sections of the Indian Act as it relates to land management. The established Land Code Development Committee represents the membership throughout the developmental phase. This is a community driven initiative and the acceptance of the land code will be determined by ratification vote of the First Nation Members.

The Land Code Staff & Committee along with Chief & Council are currently reviewing the Draft Kettle & Stony Point Land Code. Once this is complete it will be distributed to

ALL ELIGIBLE VOTING MEMBERS OF KETTLE & STONY POINT FIRST NATION.

In order to do this and to comply with the Framework Agreement on First Nation Lands Management, the communications staff have been working on updating ALL addresses for off-reserve members.
